## A NOTE FROM PASTOR MATT

"I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth; do you not perceive it?"  
"Be alert, be present. I'm about to do something brand-new. It's bursting out! Don't you see it?"

Both quotes above are two different versions of Isaiah 43:19. The first is from the NRSV while the second one is from The Message. When I think about the month of May what comes to my mind is transitions and changes, new things happening. As a youth it meant that school was ending, and we were transitioning to summer. As an adult I appreciate the beauty of nature and seeing the transition from winter to spring to summer. Our verse from Isaiah and having the opportunity to worship together are new ways to do things, but God has always been doing new things. We just have not always perceived it. I pray that you are well and that you will be disrupted so that you too can see the new ways that God is doing things. Amen!!
